## CALLING FOR NOMINATIONS

The Pemberton Valley Dyking District (PVDD) will be holding its 73rd Annual General Meeting (AGM) and you are invited to attend this event. You will gain a great overview of what the PVDD does, see what projects the dyking district completed throughout 2019 and what projects are planned or in progress for 2020.

In March 2020, due to the COVID-19 pandemic, Improvement Districts were given direction to postpone AGMs, and the deadline was extended to December 31, 2020. Improvement Districts are now encouraged to safely conduct physically distant AGMs and elections that comply with directions of the Provincial Health Officer (PHO).

The PVDD would like to ask individuals who plan on attending the 2020 AGM to RSVP at [trustees@pvdd.ca](mailto:trustees@pvdd.ca), to allow the PVDD to plan its AGM accordingly, date and venue to be announced. Only those who RSVP will attend the AGM and be notified of the date and venue. RSVP deadline is September 24, 2020, at 5:00 pm. **Election: One trustee for a three (3) year term – outgoing Trustee Chad Gilmore is willing to stand for another three (3) year term.**

At this time, and in preparation for the AGM, the PVDD would like to call for Trustee nominations to be emailed to the office at [trustees@pvdd.ca](mailto:trustees@pvdd.ca). Nominations must include a letter of acceptance from the nominee (including contact information), in order for that individual to be considered a candidate for election. Please contact the office at 604-894-6632 if you do not receive an email verification for your nomination, or if you have any other questions. Deadline for Trustee nominations is September 21, 2020, at 5:00 pm.

### **Elector Eligibility: (ID must be presented)**

**Only persons attending the election and meeting the following eligibility requirements are entitled to vote:**

- A Canadian Citizen
- Eighteen years of age, or older
- An owner of land within the Pemberton Valley Dyking District boundaries
- A resident of the province of British Columbia for the prior six months
- Legal representative of an owner of land within the Pemberton Valley Dyking District boundaries
- Authorized agent of a corporation or board that owns land within the Pemberton Valley Dyking District boundaries. The authorized agent must deliver a letter in writing on company letterhead before the election begins. That authorized agent must sign a Statutory Declaration Form prior to voting.

### **Trustee Eligibility:**

- Every person who is qualified to be an elector is also qualified to be a Trustee
- The spouse of a qualified elector may also hold the office of Trustee
